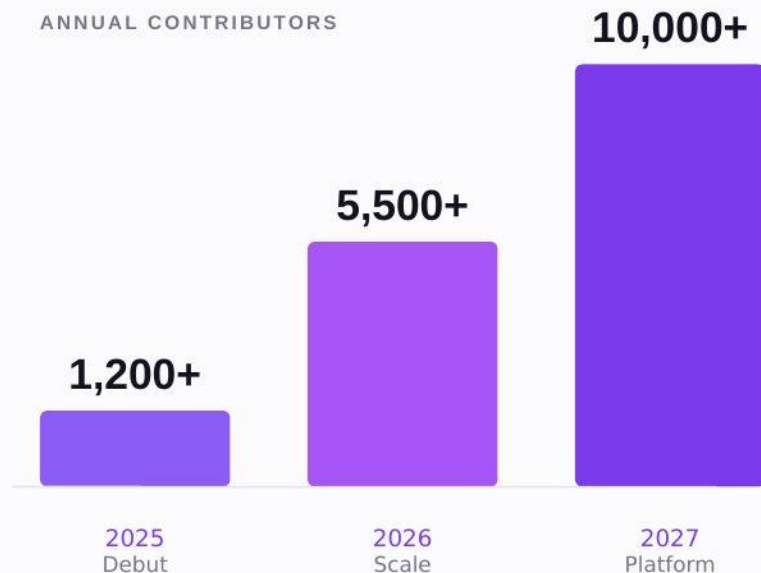

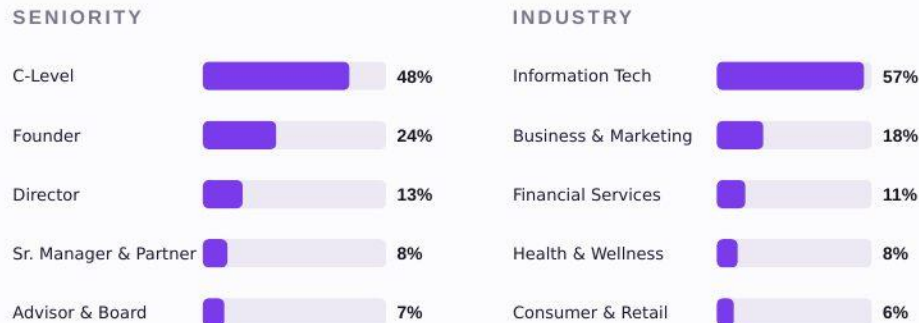

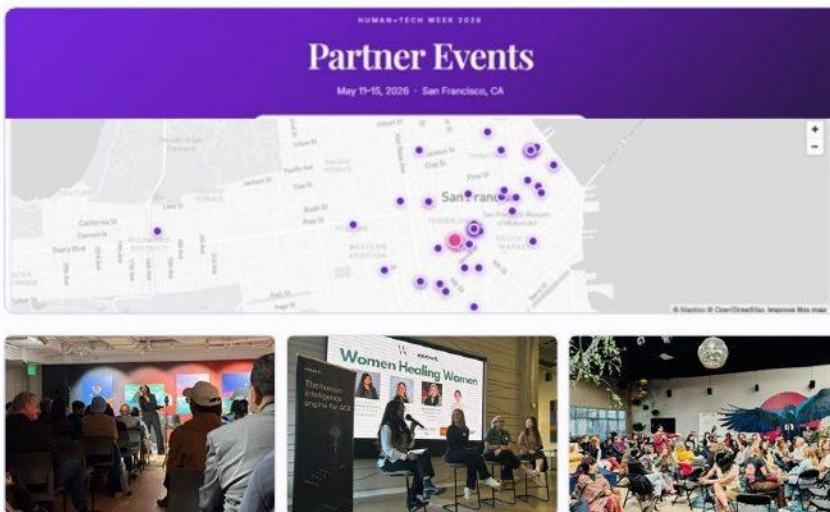

I went into **Human+Tech Week's** HOPE Summit thinking about coaching, and I came out thinking about incentives.

I've known and seen **Daniel Kraft**, MD, for 10+ years, and his opening keynote on human and AI co-evolution in health set the language for the rest of the day. Watching him bring longevity, prevention, care delivery, and personalization into one architecture was the most useful version of that argument I have seen made in a room of operators. Catching up with him afterward was a lot of fun, as usual.

Watching **Larry Brilliant** on stage was truly inspiring and humbling on so many levels, and the hour-plus private conversation I had with him afterward instantly became one of my favorite conversations of all time.

The AI Health Coaching panel got into the questions our team has been working through for years. What does responsible and validated coaching look like in the age of AI when the goal is measurable behavior change? How do you build personalization that earns the name? Good to see **Giuseppe Barbolino**, PhD from Tonal up there and chat with him after the session.

As always, it was wonderful to see our investor **Wei-Wu He, Ph.D. (HeHe)**, who gave a compelling and passionate keynote on the frontier of human longevity.

The closing panel made clear that whoever solves the payment-model problem at scale gets to shape how prevention gets delivered for the next twenty years. Sleep AI had already figured this out through reimbursement work with statutory health insurers in Germany, and with MAHA Elevate, similar models may bridge the gap in the US.

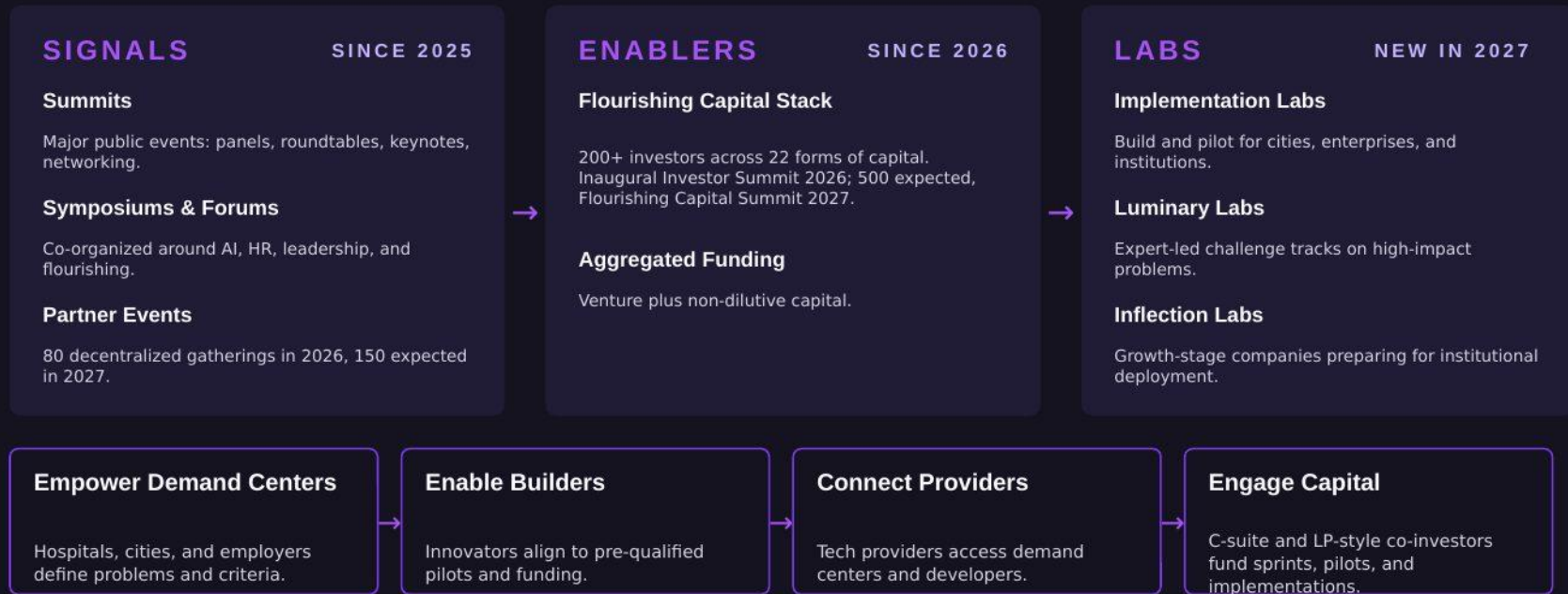

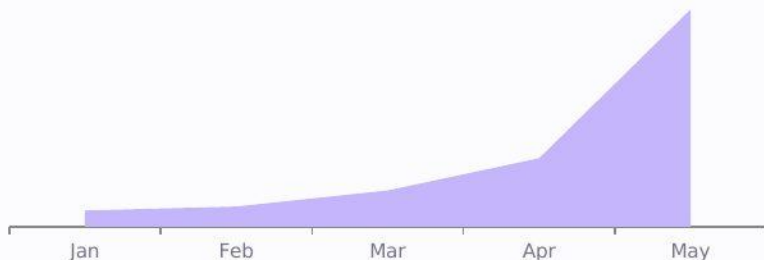
